The Challenge

A construction firm specializing in building rehabilitation faced inefficiencies due to an outdated estimation application built in Microsoft Access 1997.

Key pain points included:

- No centralized, modern platform for project estimates
- Limited support for multiple users and data integrity
- Difficulty scaling or integrating with future systems

The organization needed a new system that could replicate their legacy functionality while modernizing the interface and architecture.

Our Solution

Konverge collaborated with the company to replace its legacy estimator with a fully web-based solution. Built using .NET and SQL Server, the application included:

- Role-based access: Admin and estimator user roles for secure data entry and management
- Estimation workflows: Filter, sort, and archive project estimates with templated reuse
- Calculation engine: Auto-compute dimensions, volumes, costs, and margins
- Cost magnifier tool: Suggest pricing based on past similar project data
- Report exports: Generate field work orders and summaries in PDF or CSV formats
- Database controls: Manage rate libraries and reusable assemblies



- Web-responsive interface with support for all major browsers
- Smart project filters by location, timeframe, and type
- Project templates and copy functionality for speed and consistency
- Data validation and change tracking
- Admin module for rate and assembly management
